



## **Immigration Status and SFHSA Programs**

Eligibility requirements for public benefits

The San Francisco Human Services Agency (SFHSA) provides valuable public benefits for immigrants, from CalFresh food assistance and Medi-Cal health coverage to cash assistance through CalWORKs, County Adult Assistance Programs (CAAP), and Refugee Cash Assistance.

The information below identifies which of those programs your clients may be eligible for based on their immigration status and the required documentation.

Every situation is different. Contact the Bay Area Legal Aid Free Advice Hotline (800) 551-5554 for questions about how receiving public benefits may affect immigration status.

## **Proof of Immigration Status for SHFSA Programs**

If SFHSA is unable to verify a person's immigration status through available electronic sources, we may ask for documentation to prove their status within 90 days.

Clients may only need to provide one or two documents below depending on their status and the program requirements.
