In-Home Supportive Services

Get care at home.



The In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program provides paid assistance to incomeeligible older adults and people with disabilities so they can remain safely in their own homes.

Eligibility for IHSS

IHSS recipients must:

- · Be Medi-Cal eligible,
- · Have qualified immigration status,
- · Be a California resident.
- · Live in their own home, and
- Be at risk for pre-mature institutionalization

County Social Workers do assessments in applicants' homes when they apply, annually, and when there is a change in circumstance to determine service hours.

IHSS Benefits and Services

Examples of IHSS services include:

- Household chores
- Meal preparation
- Routine laundry
- Shopping and errands
- · Personal care services such as dressing, feeding, etc.
- Accompaniment to and from health-related appointments
- · Paramedical services as authorized by a physician



How to Get a Care Provider

IHSS is a consumer-directed program, which means you can hire and manage your own care provider. Most IHSS recipients hire a family member or a person known to them. If you do not have a provider, we can help you find one. Consult with your IHSS Social Worker regarding your options.
