Community Supports & Health Services

Recommendation: address discrimination experienced within the emergency room and medical services

Action: pilot an ageism and ableism training geared towards health care professionals.

Transportation

Recommendation: Address the impact of transportation network companies (TNC's) on people with disabilities through policy or practice.

Action: Require TNC's to ensure accessible accommodations.

Resiliency & Disaster Preparedness

Recommendation: Ensure that there is support so that seniors, people with disabilities, and their caregivers are prepared for a disaster.

Action: Develop an outreach campaign to encourage registration with AlertSF.

Resiliency & Disaster Preparedness

Recommendation: Implement policies and procedures that account for and respond promptly to people with disabilities and seniors.

Action: Ensure that there is a strategy in place for evacuating people with mobility challenges living in multistory buildings.
