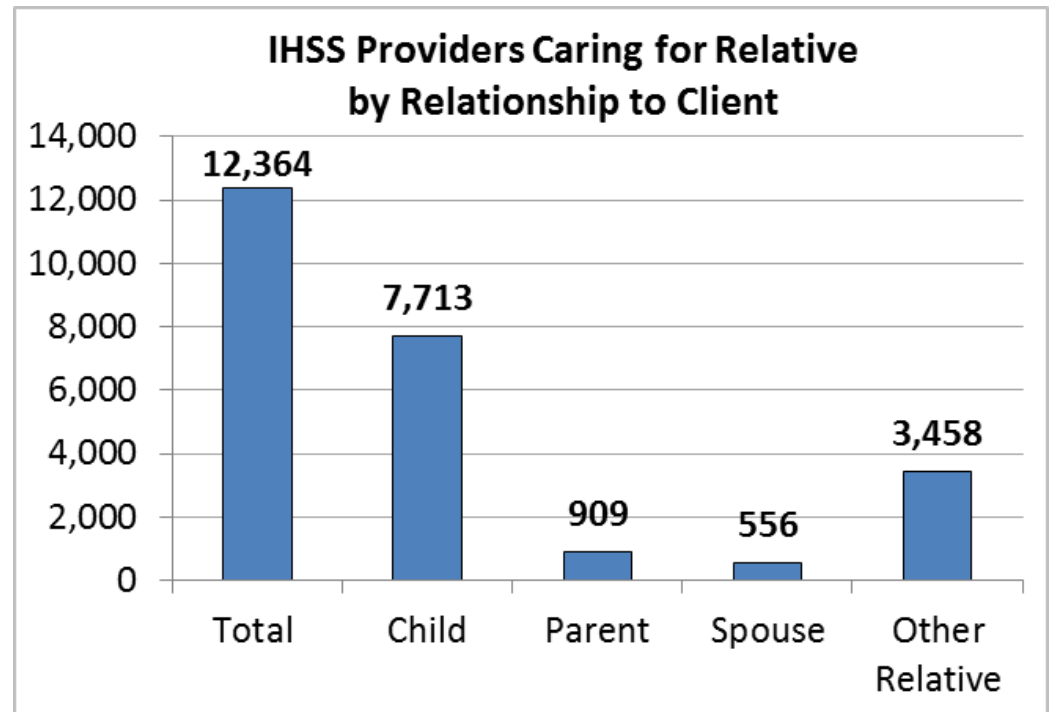
Caregivers: General Trends

- Primarily women (60%)
- Average age of 49
- About 60% are employed in other part-time or full-time positions
- Most vulnerable to negative health impacts:
 - Higher-hour caregivers
 - Co-resident caregivers
 - Primary caregivers

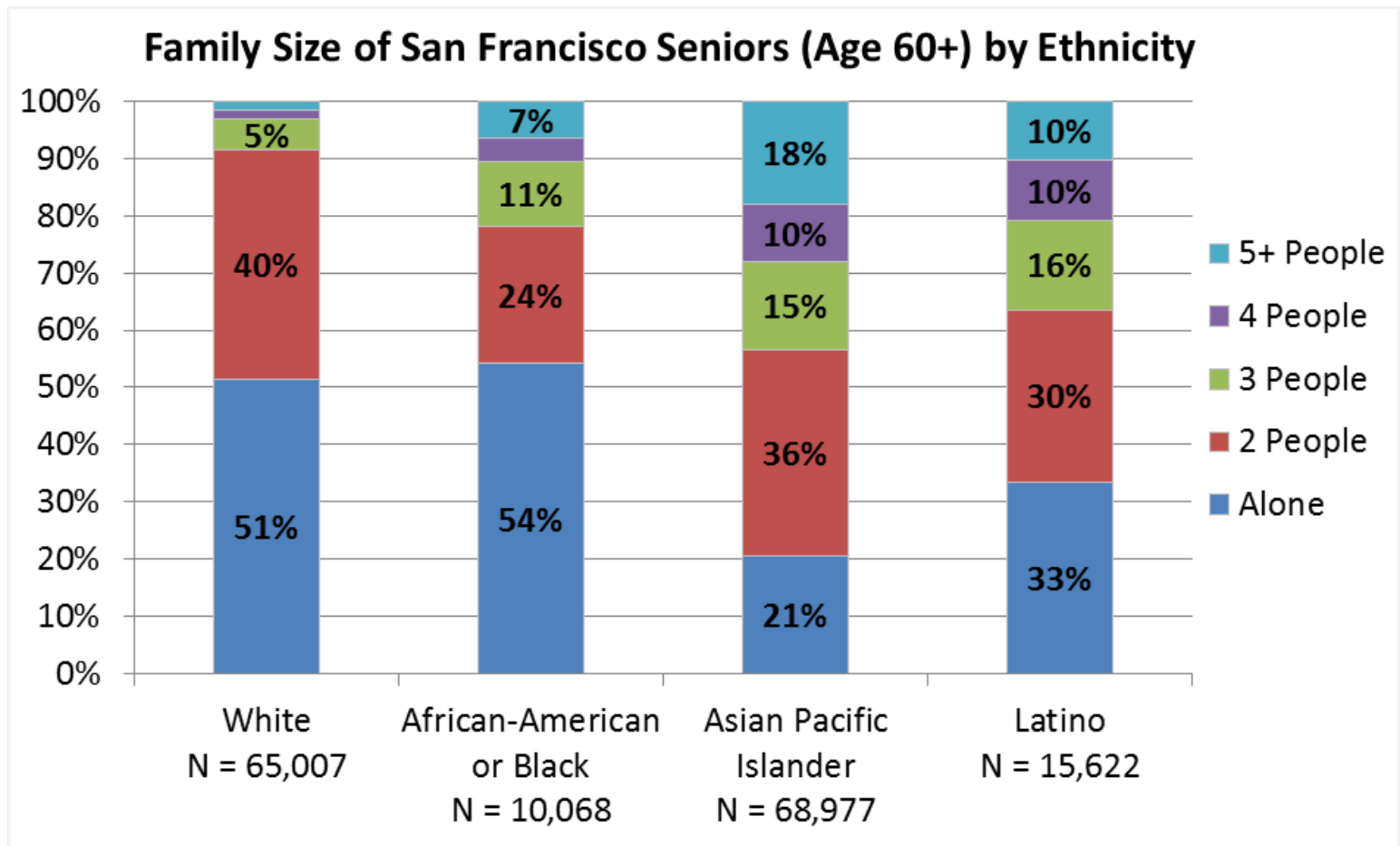

 - 89% below age 65
- Language:
 - Cantonese (44%)
 - English (30%)

 - Visitacion Valley: 10%



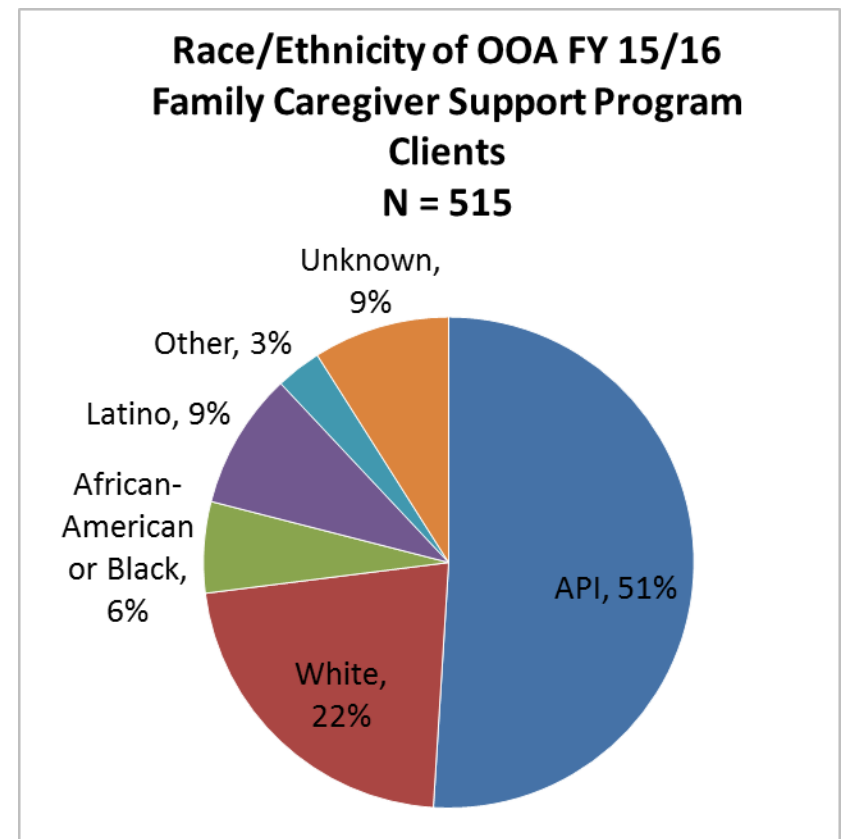
Caregivers: San Francisco Seniors by Living Arrangement



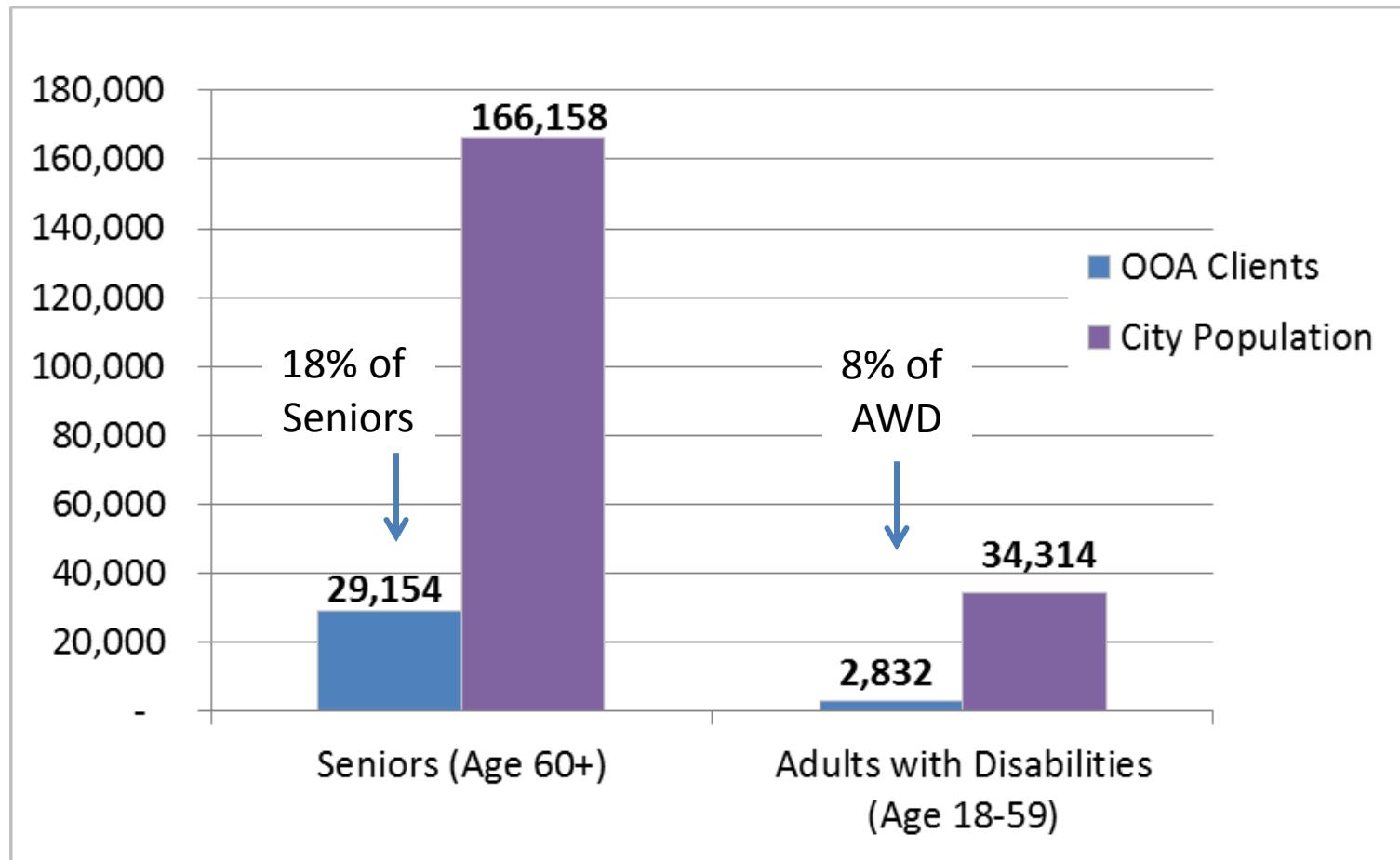
Caregivers: OOA Family Caregiver Support Program

- Average age: 61

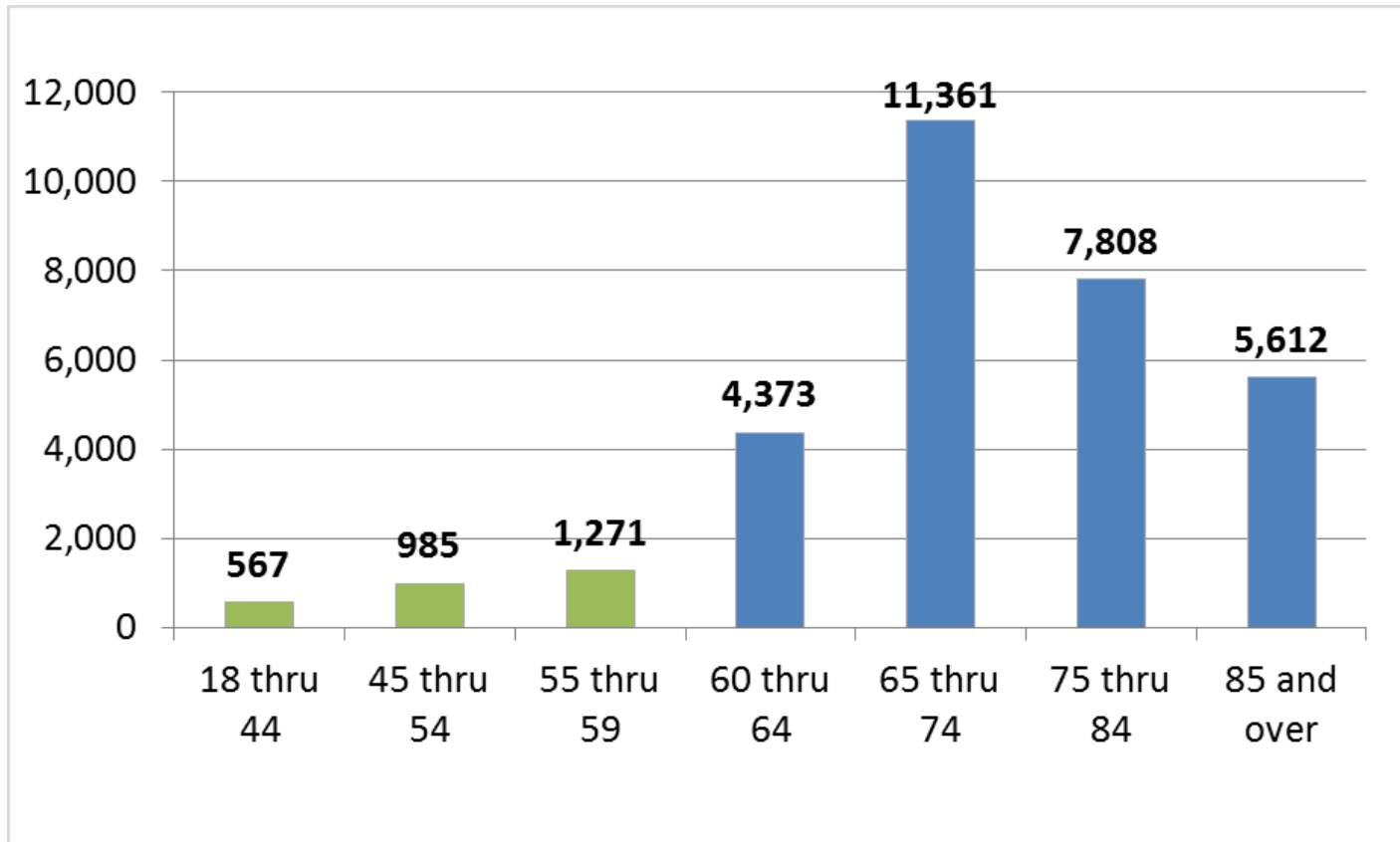


By the Numbers: # Served by OOA Clients vs. City Population

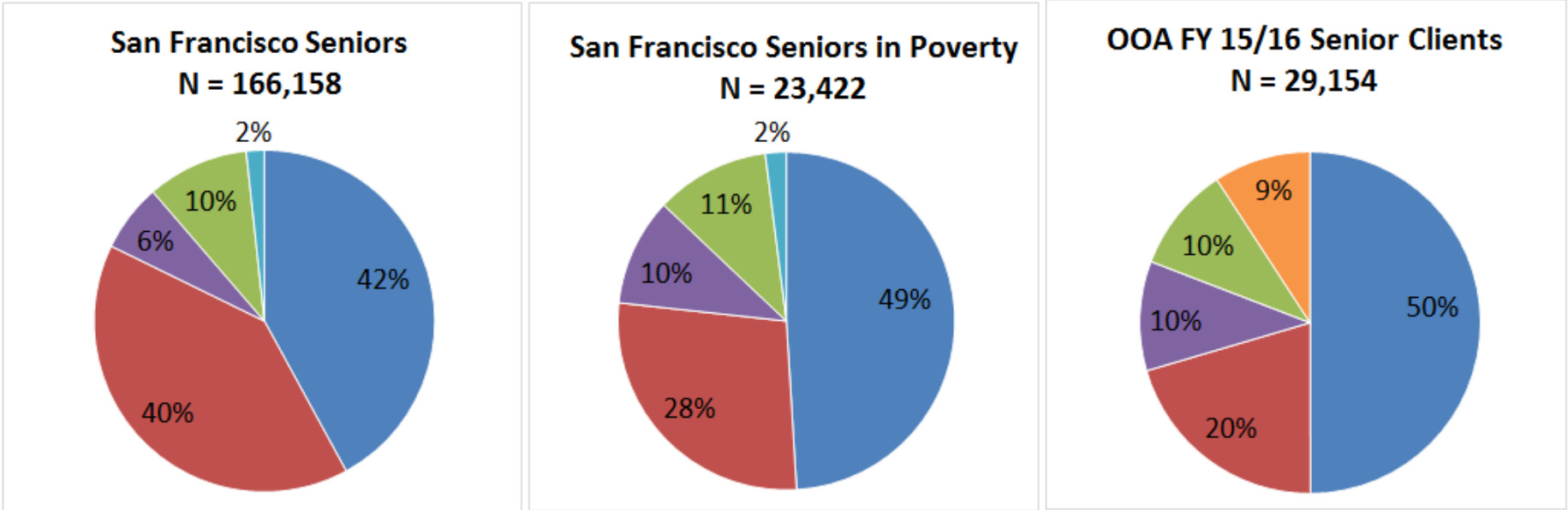


OOA Clients by Age

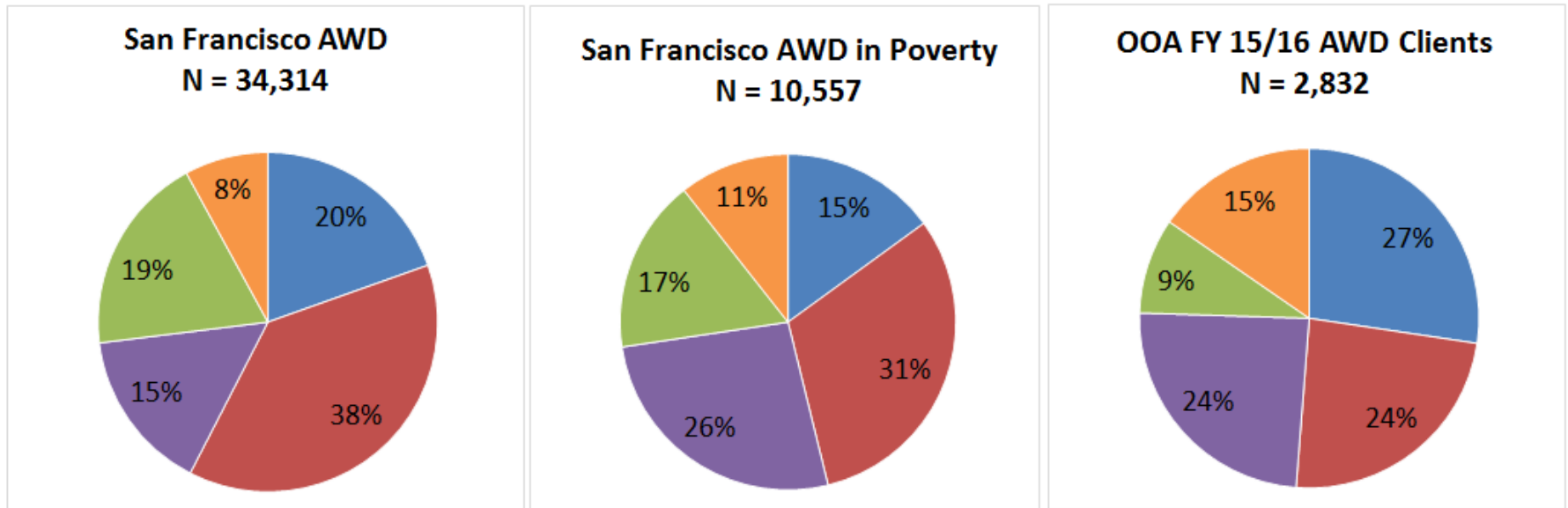
Race/Ethnicity of SF Seniors and OOA Clients



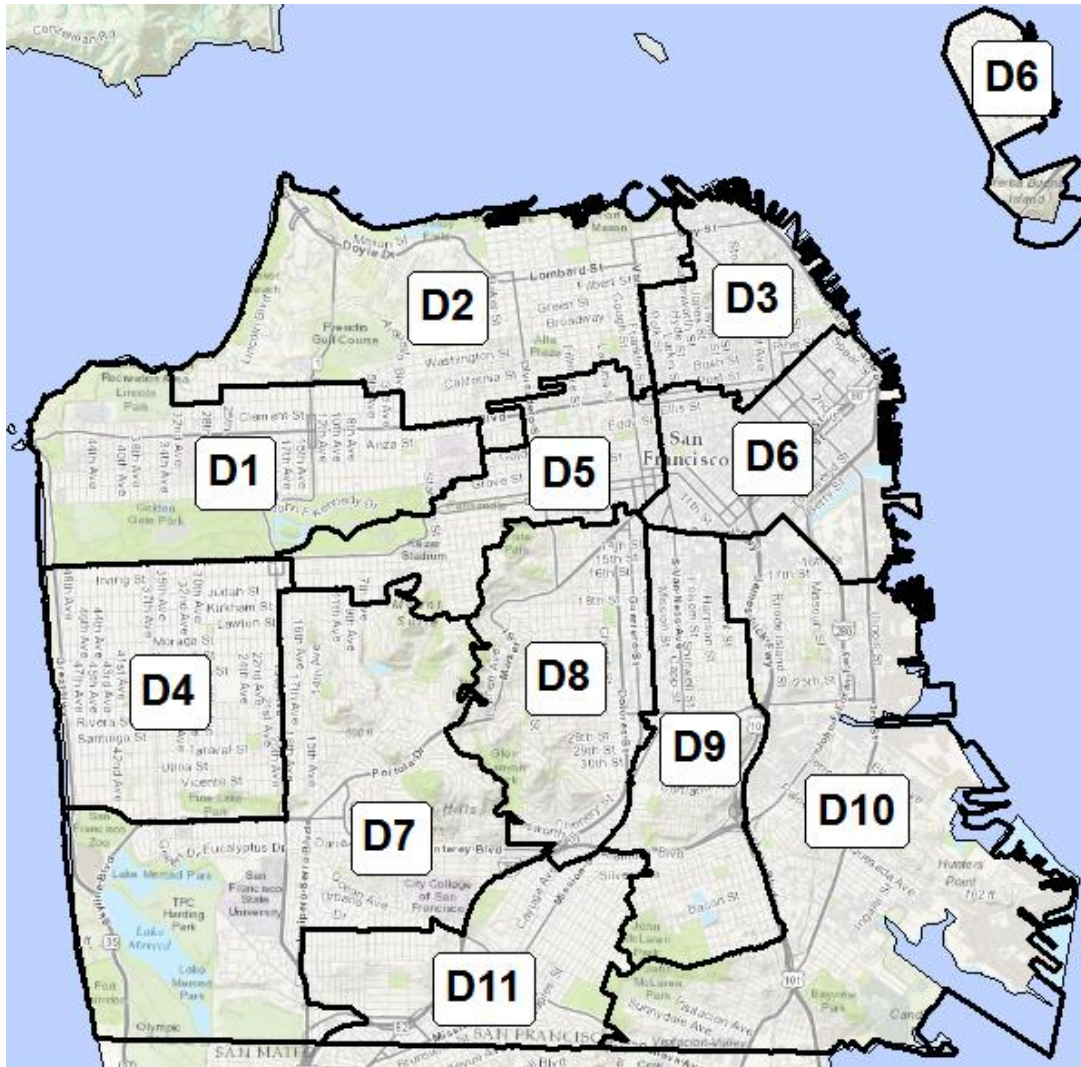

Race/Ethnicity of SF AWD and OOA Clients



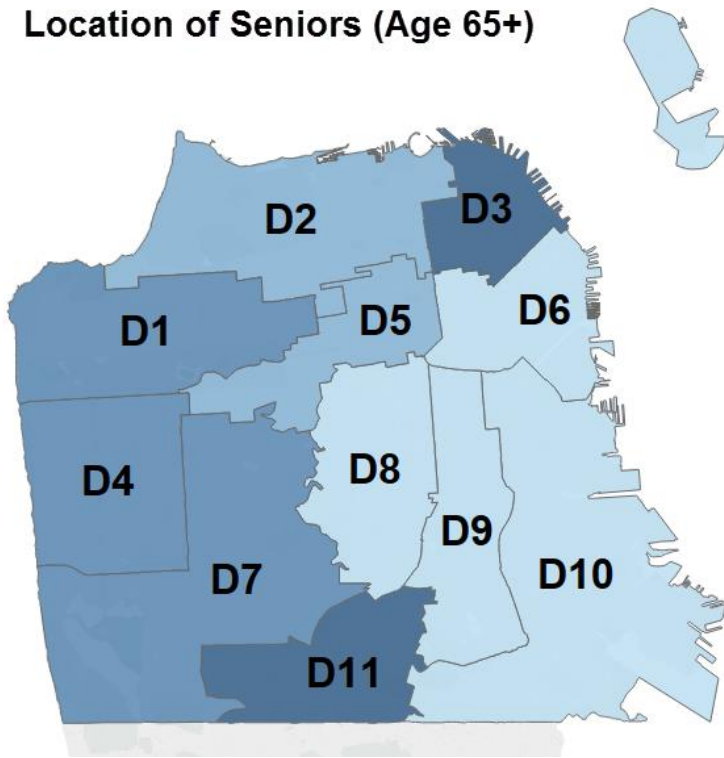

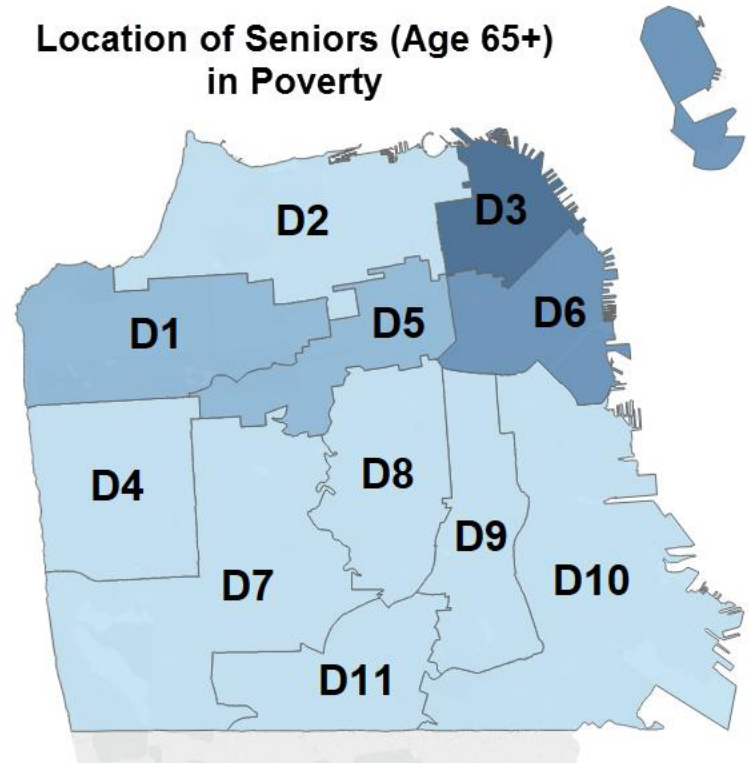

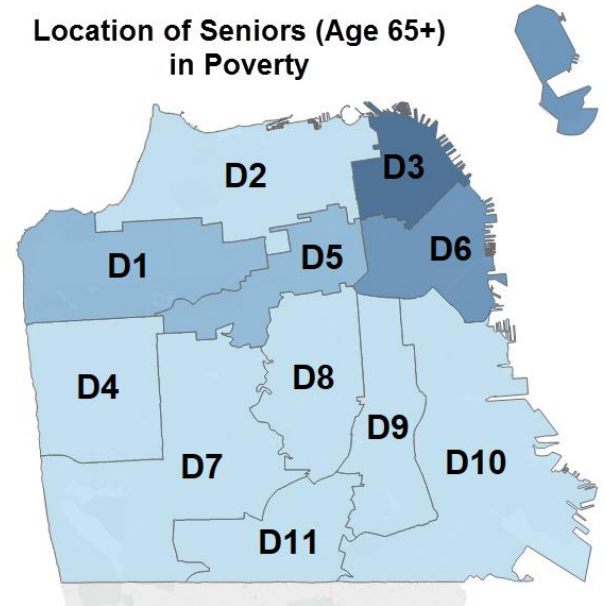
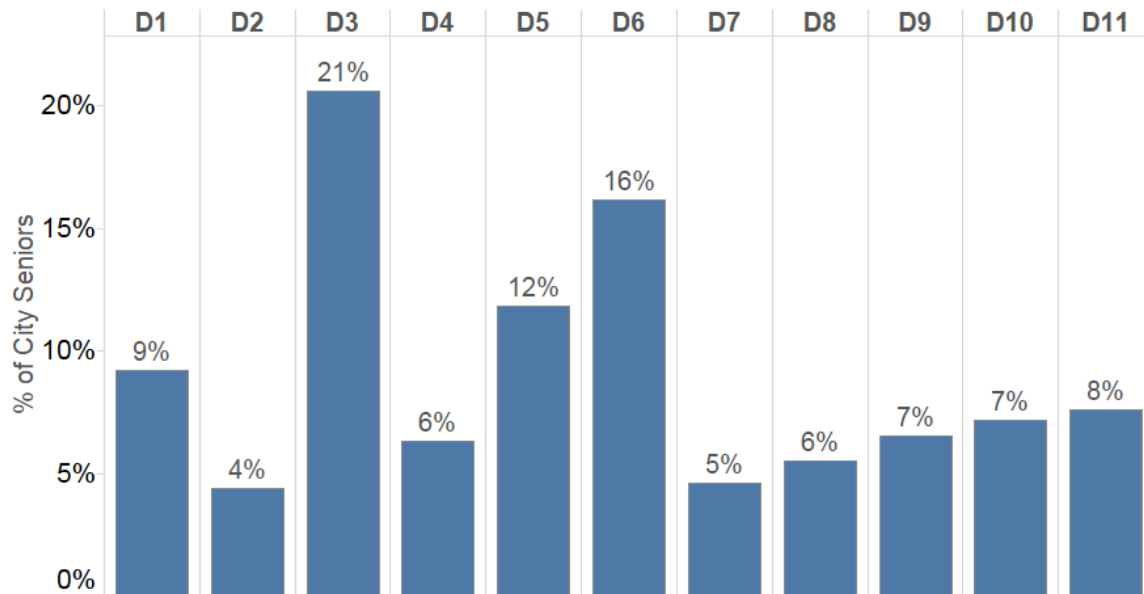
Location of Seniors (Age 65+)



Location of Seniors (Age 65+) in Poverty

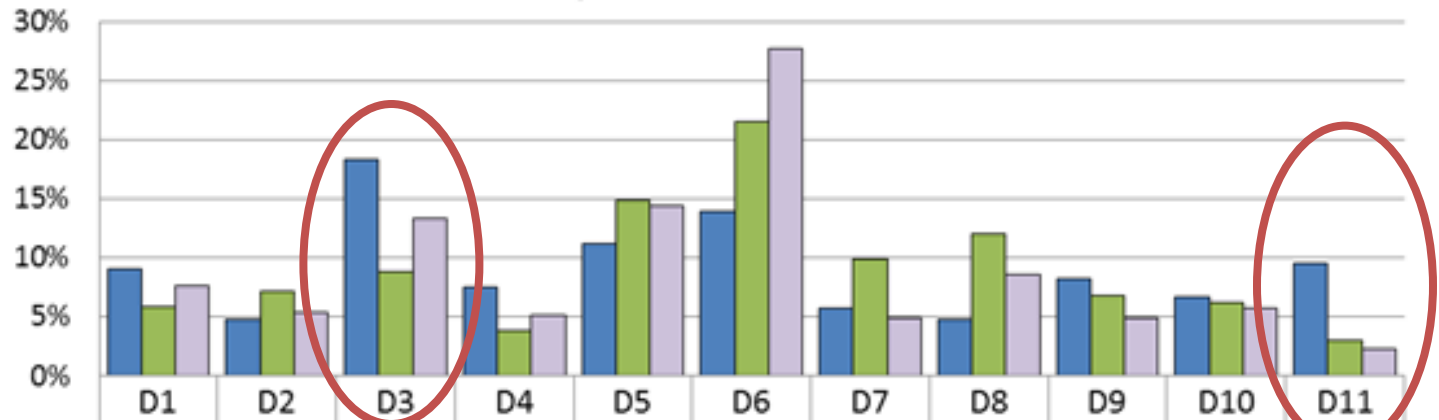


Location of SF Seniors in Poverty



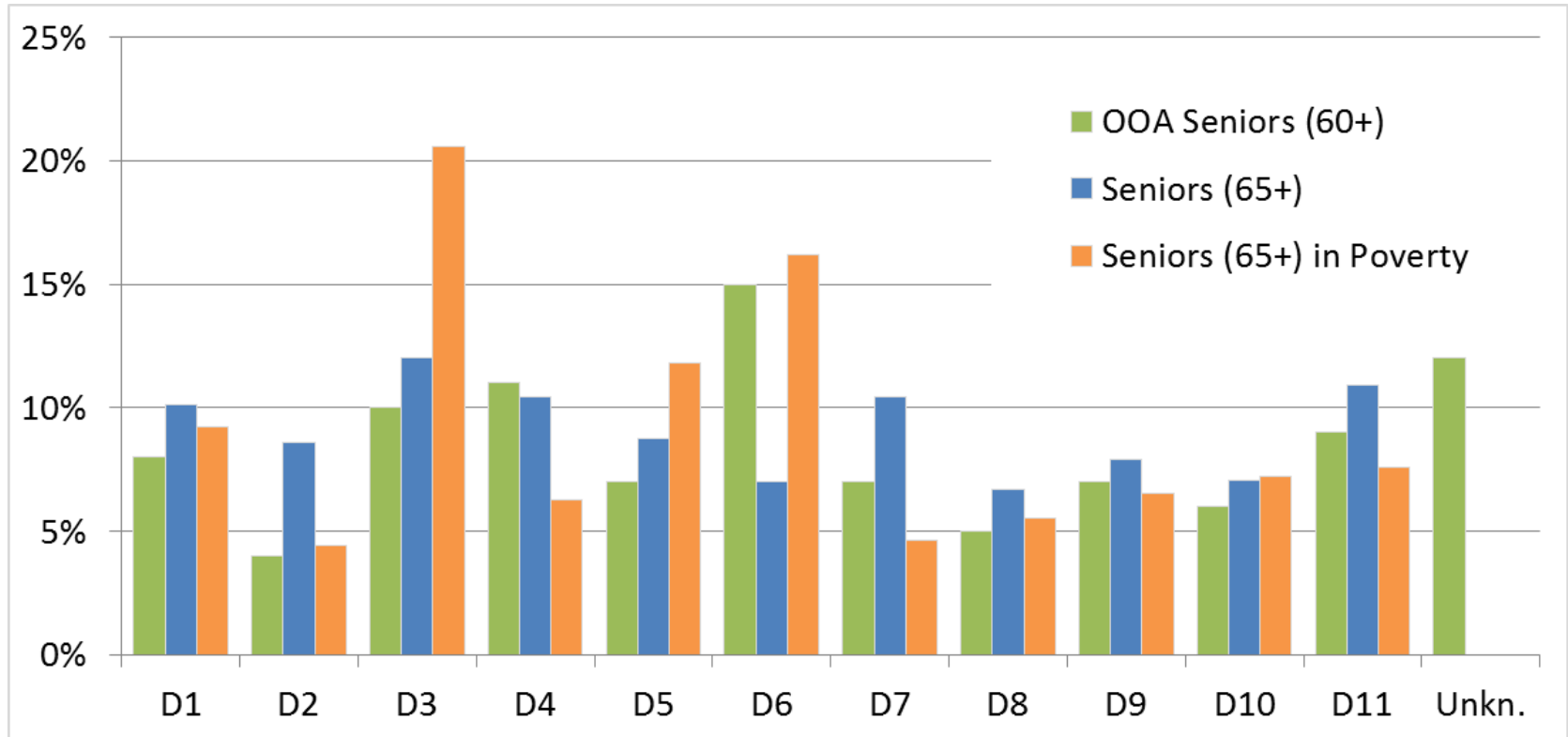

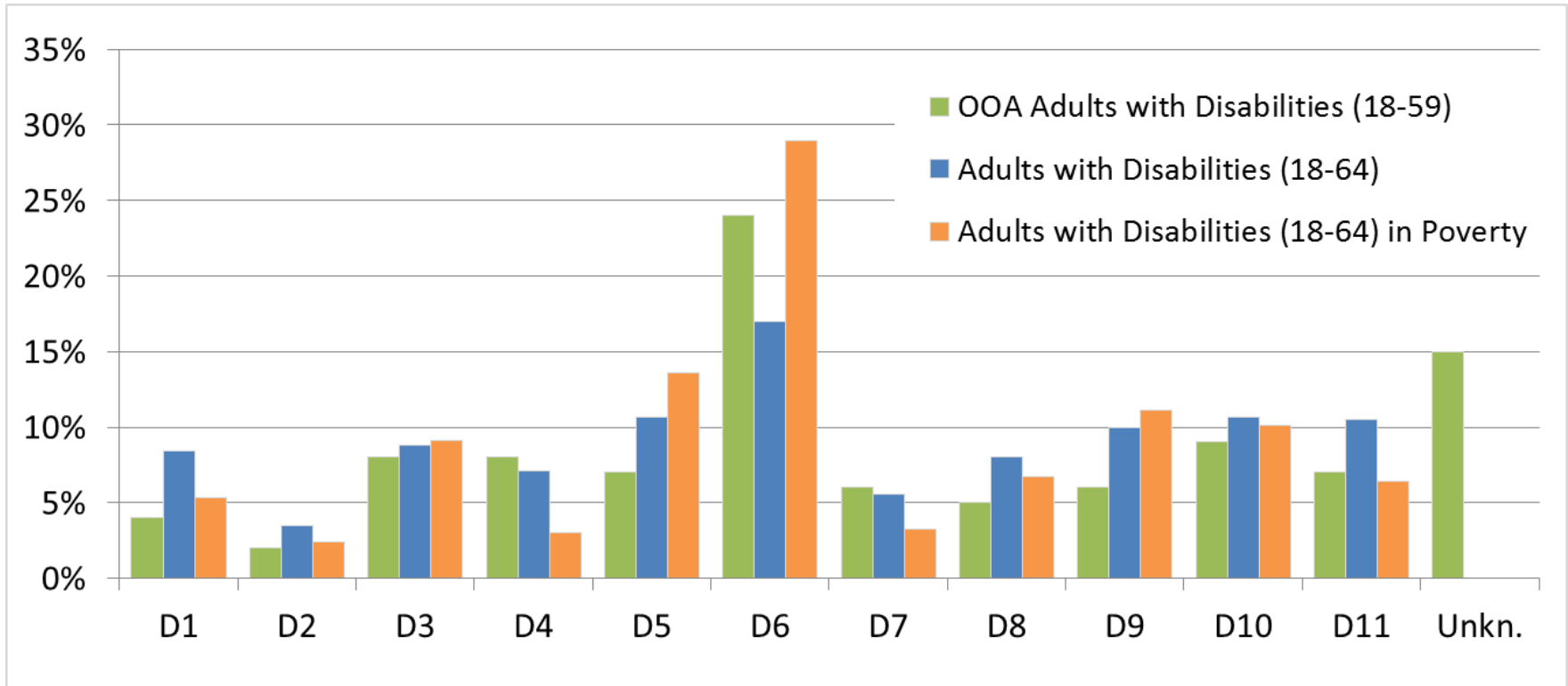

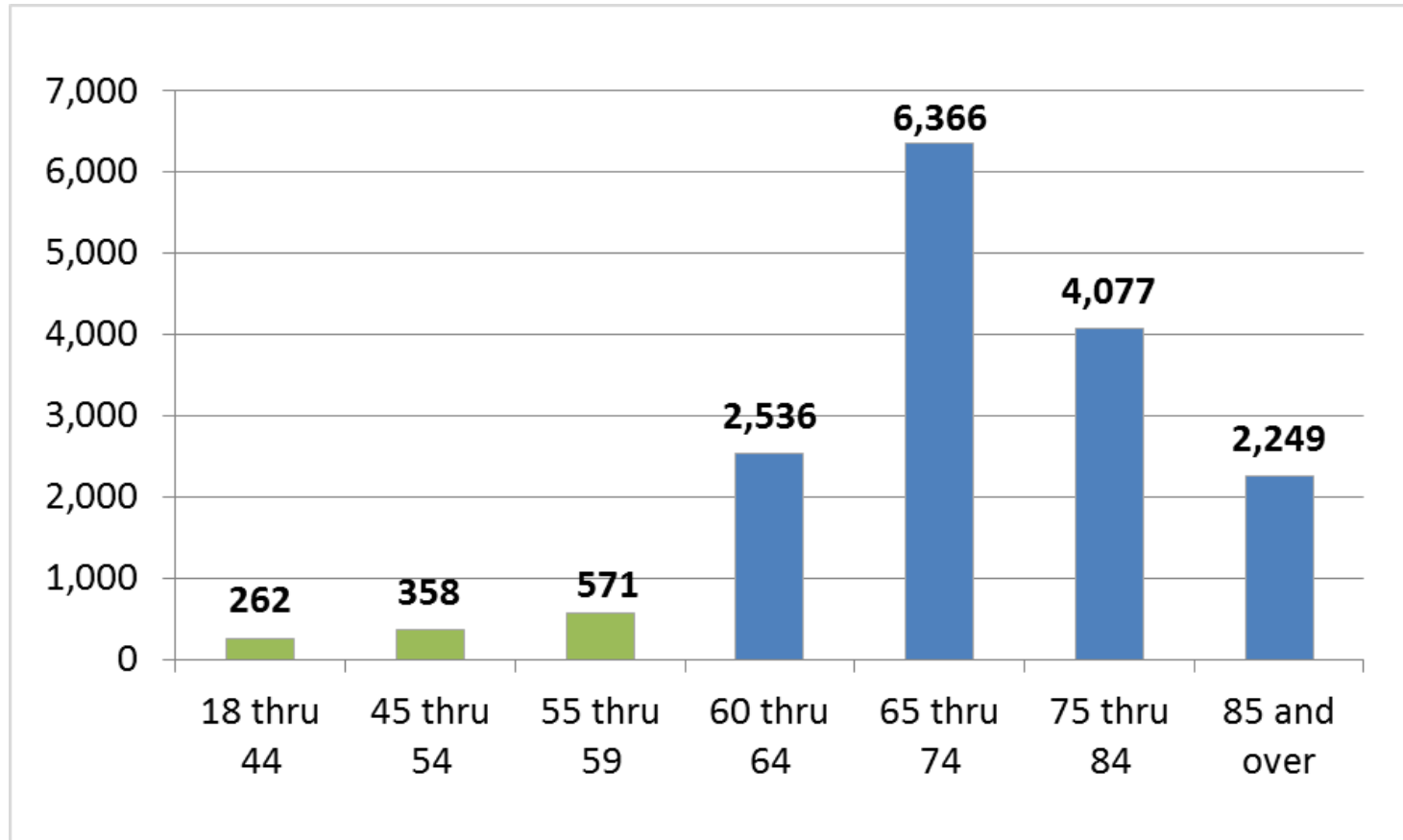

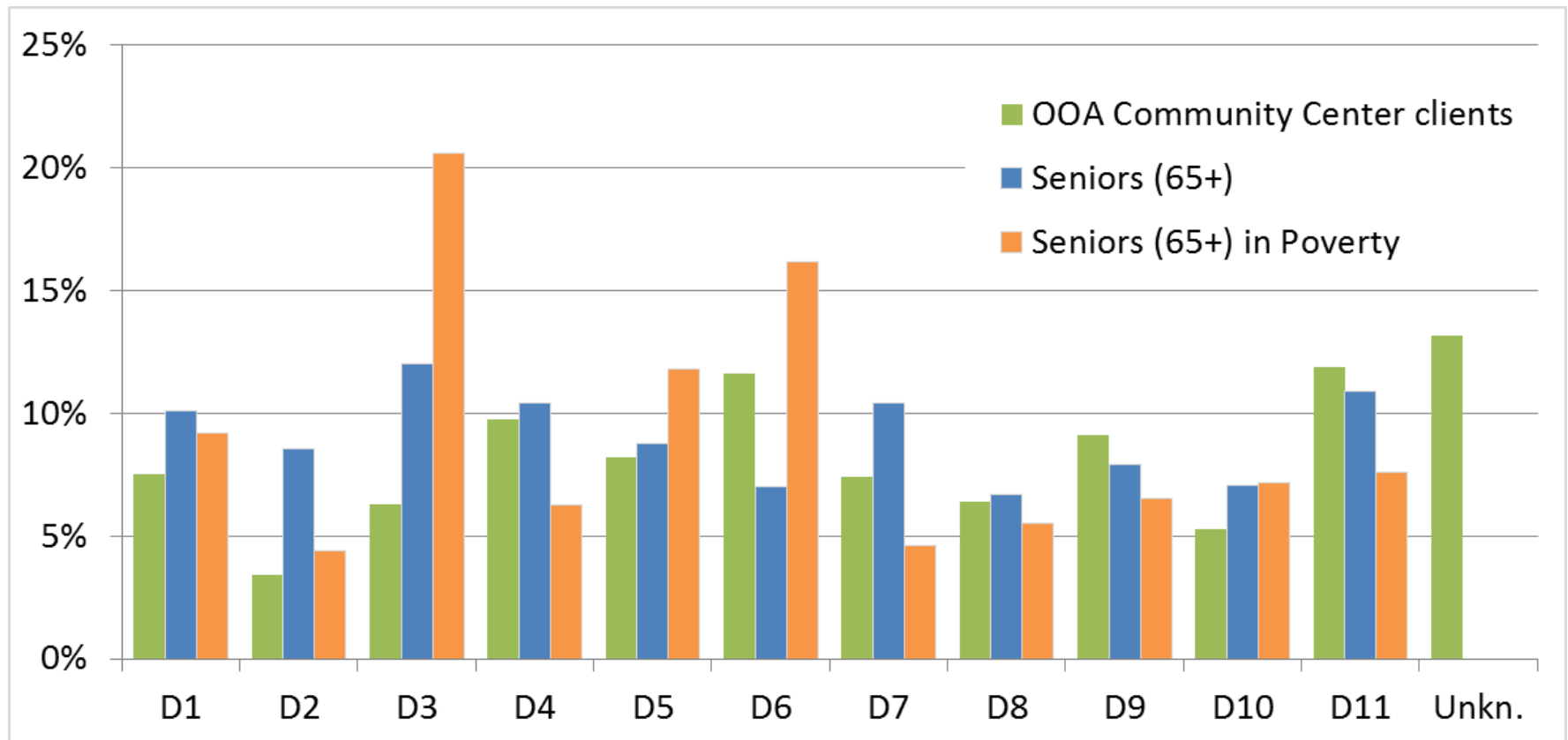
